Dear Parents,

We will have three positions available on the Ridgeline Elementary Community Council for the 2014 – 2015 school year. We are looking for parents from both the Highland and Suncrest communities who would be interested in serving on this council. The parent with the highest votes from each community will be selected. The third position will be filled by the nominee receiving the third highest number of votes.

The purpose of the School Community Council is to build communication between the school and parents. They will also advise and vote on spending School Trust Land funds. Those serving on the Community Council will need to attend four to six meetings a year to discuss school issues. The term of office is two years. Names of those applying will be placed on a ballot, and an election will be held May 21 through 23.
